NOTES

1. The Army Air Forces Training Command, with headquarters at Fort Worth, Texas, was activated on 7 July 43 and includes all stations and activities formerly under the jurisdiction of the Army Air Forces Flying Training Command and the Army Air Forces Technical Training Command, as indicated herein. The Army Air Forces Flying Training Command and the Army Air Forces Technical Training Command were discontinued coincident with the activation of the Army Air Forces Training Command.

2. The Army Air Forces Southeast Training Center, Maxwell Field, Montgomery, Alabama; the Army Air Forces Gulf Coast Training Center, Randolph Field, Texas; and the Army Air Forces West Coast Training Center, 1104 West 8th Street, Santa Ana, California, have been redesignated as the Army Air Forces Eastern Flying Training Command, the Army Air Forces Central Flying Training Command, and the Army Air Forces Western Flying Training Command respectively, without change in location of headquarters and with no material change in area of jurisdiction.

3. The 3rd District, Army Air Forces Technical Training Command, Tulsa, Oklahoma, and the 5th District, Army Air Forces Technical Training Command, Miami, Florida, have been discontinued. The former Technical Training Command has been reorganized into three Technical Training Commands. The former 1st District of the Army Air Forces Technical Training Command, Greensboro, North Carolina, has been redesignated as the Army Air Forces Eastern Technical Training Command; the former 2nd District, 455 Lake Avenue, St. Louis, Missouri, has been redesignated as the Army Air Forces Central Technical Training Command; and the former 4th District, 1108 15th Street, Denver, Colorado, has been redesignated as the Army Air Forces Western Technical Training Command, without change in location of their headquarters. The stations which were assigned to the 3rd and 5th Districts have been reassigned to the Technical Training Commands as indicated herein.

4. It is requested that any errors, omissions, or changes noted be reported promptly to this Headquarters, Attention: Management Control Section.

6. The titles of stations and installations used herein are the official designations as announced by The Adjutant General, Washington, D. C., and will be used in all references to stations or schools.
