ATLAS ICBM SITE

SEWARD MISSILE LAUNCH CENTER & LAUNCH COMMAND CONTROL CENTER: 551-11

3 miles northwest of Seward, Seward County, Nebraska.

Prior: 551-11 LC/LCCC, 1 of 12 Atlas-F Intercontinental Ballistic Missiles assigned to the 551st Strategic Missile Squadron (SMS), 818th Strategic Aerospace Division, Lincoln AFB, Ne.

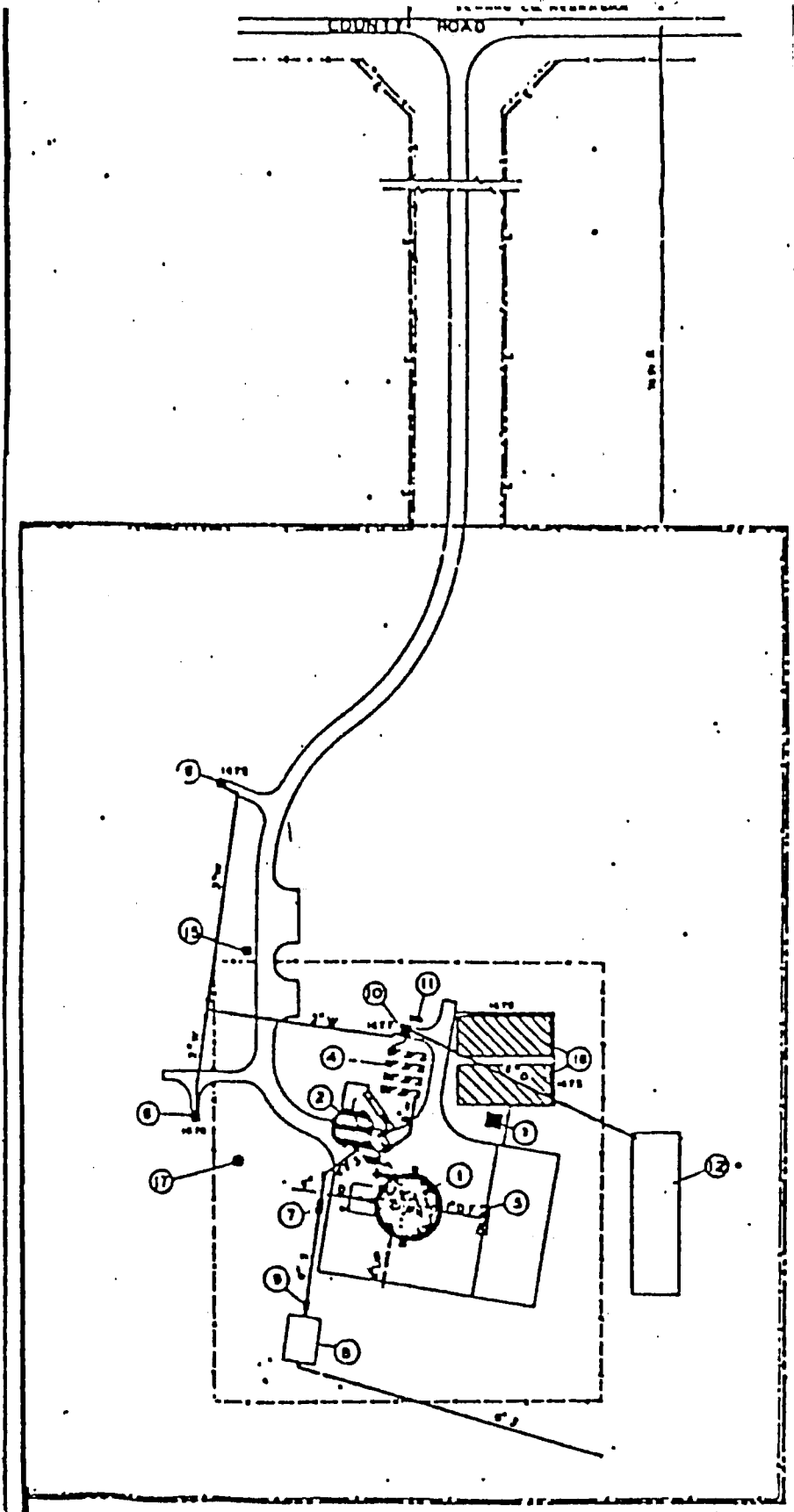
551st SMS was activated by Strategic Air Command Headquarters on 1 April 1961.

As a result of the Cuban missile crisis of October 1962 the 551st SMS was placed on alert.

551st SMS Atlas-F ICBMs were removed from alert on 12 April 1965 completing operational phaseout of the Strategic Air Command's Atlas weapon system.

551st SMS shipped the last Atlas-F ICBM from Lincoln AFB to a storage facility at Vandenberg AFB, Ca. on 20 April 1965. The missiles were later used as launch vehicles for U.S. Air Force research and development programs.
