**AMMUNITION ALLOWANCES FOR INDIVIDUAL TRAINING
AND PELLET TRAINING ORGANIZATIONS**

This regulation tells how much expendable ammunition will be allowed individuals for training each fiscal year and describes pellet training authorizations. It does not cover nonexpendable training munition allowances as outlined in AFR 136—5 or for unit training as outlined in AFR 50—4.

1. Who Is Provided an Ammunition Allowance. This regulation established munition training allowances for all persons under the control of the Chief of Staff, USAF, other than non-combatant personnel (chaplains, WAFs, medical personnel, and those persons with religious convictions against use of firearms). Ammunition is authorized non-combatants who participate in training on an optional basis:

a. Individuals on duty only a part of the fiscal year may expend the full ammunition allowance in order to qualify.

b. Members of the Ready Reserve forces not in active military service are provided the same allowance as members of the Regular Air Force.

c. Foreign Government personnel and students from any branch, department, or activity of the United States Government who are attached to the Air Force as students for instruction or training are authorized the same allowances as Air Force personnel engaged in the same activity.

d. Foreign Government personnel attached to Air Force activities in overseas areas according to joint manning agreements to perform functions normally performed by Air Force personnel are authorized the same allowances as Air Force personnel.

2. Changes in Authorized Ammunition Allowances. Interim changes in ammunition allowances to meet valid training requirements will be considered by HQ USAF pending annual revision of AFR 50—41.

a. Major commanders will:

(1) Annually review allowances in this regulation to validate requirements.

(2) Forward proposed changes to HQ USAF/DPPTB on or before 1 July.

(3) Indicate number of personnel (class size and frequency involved in all requests for change to ammunition allowances.

(4) Identify request for one-time ammunition authorizations required for special projects or training not covered in this regulation.

b. Interim changes approved by HQ USAF will be sequentially numbered pending annual revision. Annual revision will be accomplished prior to 10 October.

3. Pellet Training Authorizations. Authorizations for consumable and nonconsumable pellet training components and supplies are contained in attachment 2.

4. Records and Reports of Ammunition Used. Records and reports of ammunition expended are used to establish realistic allowances to conform with training needs. Major commanders will maintain records and reports of expenditures of training ammunition allowances for individuals, units and activities as required by chapter 20, Part one, Vol I, AFM 67—1, and AFR 50—57.

5. Special Instructions. The following special instructions apply to the use of ammunition and lead pellet allowances authorized herein.

a. Qualification training allowances are considered to be average authorizations. Additional ammunition may be authorized for each individual failing to qualify.

b. Funding responsibility for local purchase items, listed in the USAF stock List (FSC 1300) will be assumed by the major command for procurement at base level.

c. Care must be taken to procure lead pellets that are compatible with the pellet training equipment in use. Deviation from consistency or specifications will cause weapon malfunctions.
