MATCH NUMBER 1: U.S. INTERNATIONAL CLAY PIGEON CHAMPIONSHIP

WEATHER: Hot, Dry, Partly Cloudy, and Calm.

COURSE OF FIRE: 300 Targets. Twelve (12) stages of 25 birds each. Shooters are arranged in squads of 6 shooters each.

ARM: All kinds of shotguns including automatic models, 12 Gauge or smaller, may be used for shooting. Compensators or similar devices which may disturb the neighboring shooter are not allowed. No handicap will be given to competitors using guns with a caliber smaller than 12.

AMMUNITION: The length of the shell is not to exceed 70mm (2-3/4"). The shot is not to be larger than 2¹/₂mm (NO.6) in diameter and the load of shot not to exceed 36 grams (1-1/4 ozs.). It is not allowed to use black powder or tracer cartridges.

WEATHER: Warm, Dry, Partly Cloudy, and Calm.

COURSE OF FIRE: Running Roebuck, normal runs (60 shots and sighters) and Running Roebuck fast runs (30 shots and sighters).

ARM: Any type of rifle which fulfills the following requirements:
Weight of the rifle as used in competition shall not exceed 5 kgs. The trigger shall have a minimum pull of 0.5 kgs; sights are "free" (any sight) including scope. The rifle may be rim or centerfire within caliber .22 (5.6mm) classification.

AMMUNITION: Tracer and incendiary bullets are prohibited.

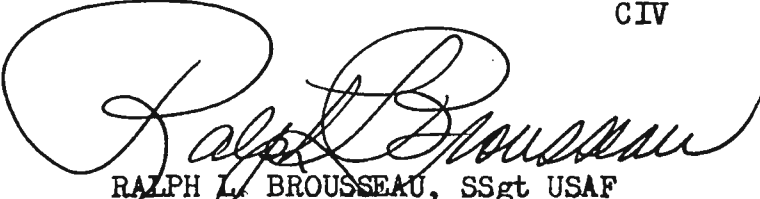
